Day 1: Arrival at Kathmandu

Your arrival to Tribhuwan International Airport and transfer to Hotel. Orientation in the evening at around 5 PM. After your orientation meeting, welcome dinner at Local restaurant.

Day 2: Flight to lukla by plane or helicopter and trek to Phakding

Early morning flight to Lukla, the gateway to Khumbu region to start the trek. The trek starts from the very day to the up-hill up-to Phakding for 3-4 hours. We will stop at Phakding and stay overnight at Sherpa Shangrila Resort. (B)

Day 3: Trek to Namche

Early morning after breakfast, we start our journey through a pine forest and walk alongside the Dudh Koshi river. We ascend on a steep trail and reach Namche Bazaar (5-6 hours) which is probably the biggest town in the Everest region. Overnight at Hotel Sherpaland. (B)

Day 4: Acclimatization at Namche

To avoid the altitude sickness, we need to acclimatization in Namche Bazaar. Namche Bazaar is the most beautiful and primary town of the Everest region. The place is occupied by the colorful market with ATMs, government office, shops, restaurants and so on. Overnight at Hotel Sherpaland. (B)

Day 5 : Heli tour to Everest Base Camp/Kalapatthar

We start the day as right on time as conceivable to relish the magnificence of Mount Everest. We fly from Namche Bazaar over Everest Base Camp, Khubmu Glacier and Kalapatthar with a helicopter. Moreover, we climb till Kala Patthar(5,555m), the most elevated height purpose of our outing. It might be a touch of testing as we climb tough in higher rise. In spite of the case, it is prescribed to take the rising. Mount Everest(8,848m) holes up behind Mount Lhotse(8,516m), which is the reason we climb to Kalapatthar to observe the strong Everest alongside other charming Himalayan pinnacles. We spend many occasions here and taste a decent cup of tea in the midst of the peacefulness of the world's most noteworthy mountains. As we slip down to Gorak Shep, we appreciate the alluring excellence of the path. We fly back to Lukla and end for a night. With save time available, we can walk around the Lukla town and grasp the
