Day 1: Drive to Chitwan via tourist bus

Kathmandu to Chitwan by tourist bus, (car or flight is optional) and transfer to Hotel, Welcome drinks, Lunch, and Tharu Village visit, Museum and sunset tour, Tharu Cultural show and Dinner.

Day 2: Activities in Chitwan

Day 3: Drive to Pokhara

Drive to Pokhara by tourist bus (5-6 Hours' drive) or flight optional.

Max Altitude Pokhara (822 m)

Duration Drive (5-6 hrs)

Overnight Mount Kailash Resort or similar

Meal Breakfast



Day 4: Drive to Sarangkot

Drive to Sarangkot for sunset and sunrise view. After breakfast sightseeing tour in Pokhara (Davis falls, Gupteshor cave, World peace pagoda, Pumdikot & International Mountain Museum etc.)

Max Altitude Sarangkot (1,600 m)

Overnight Mount Kailash Resort or similar Meal Breakfast

Day 5: Drive back to Kathmandu

Drive back to Kathmandu by tourist bus or flight (Flight Optional). Transfer to your hotel and end of the trip.

Max Altitude Kathmandu (1,400 m)
